She has completed works up to 400 feet long and 90 feet tall, navigating lifts, scaffolding, and the physical demands of large-scale installations with ease. Her approach balances artistic intuition with logistical problem-solving, ensuring each mural is both visually compelling and structurally sound.

Her murals can be found across the United States and internationally, each shaped by the unique character of its location. Whether painting in dense urban districts, rural communities, or globally recognized arts destinations, her goal remains consistent: to create work that transforms space, resonates with the people who encounter it, and holds lasting meaning. Known for her reliability and collaborative approach, Caskey's work goes beyond beautification—fostering identity, connection, and pride within the communities it serves.

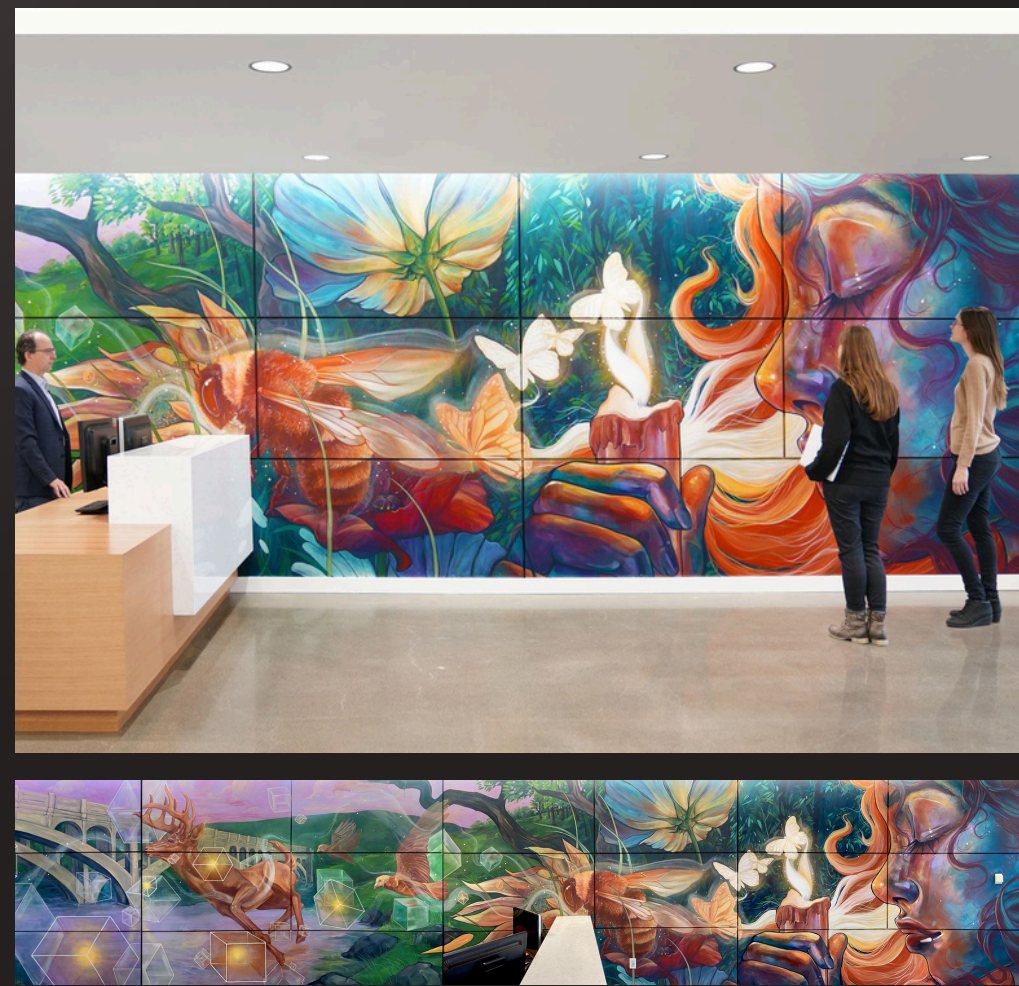

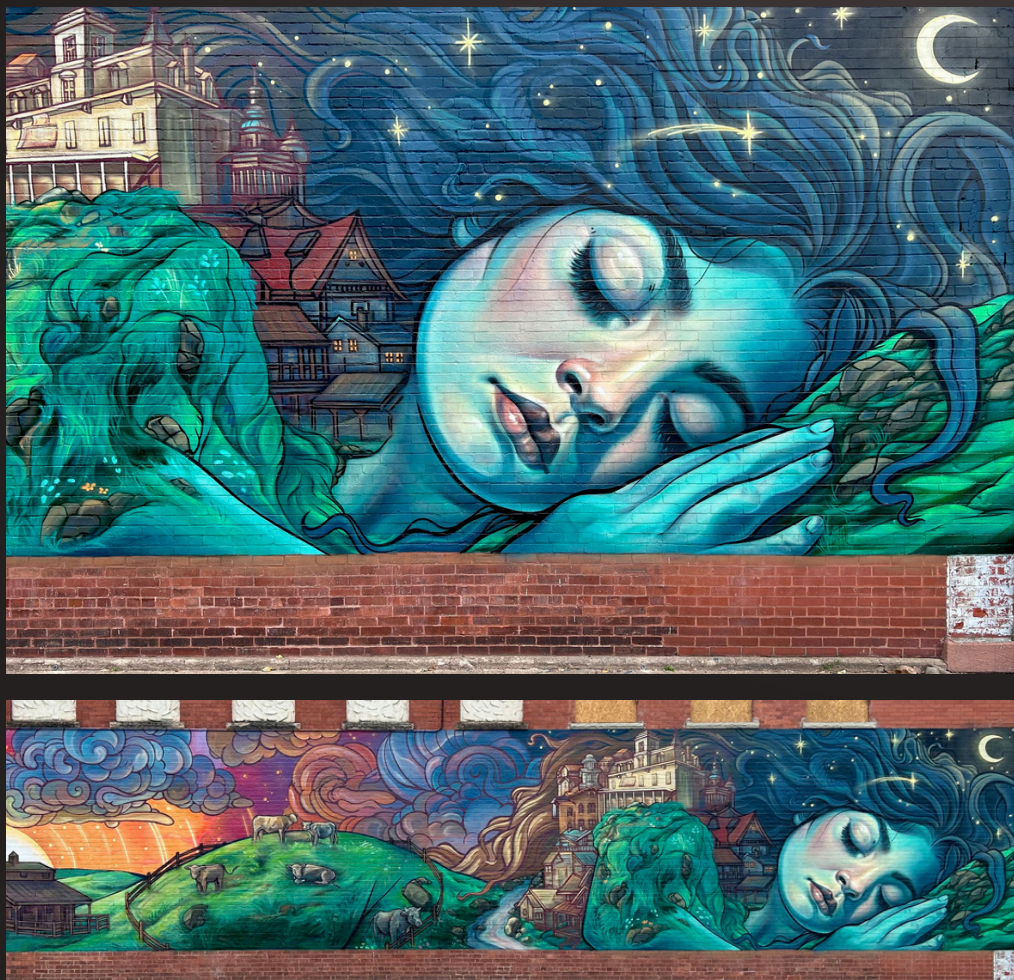

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# PRICING

Murals are typically priced between \$40–\$80 per square foot, determined by design complexity, surface conditions, and execution method.

For mural execution, 50% of the total mural cost is due before painting begins, with the remaining 50% due upon completion of the mural.

(Select projects may be quoted at a flat rate at the artist's discretion.)

## Project Estimate Includes

**Design Fee:** \$1,000 (non-refundable)

**Labor:** To be determined based on scope and site conditions

**Materials:** To be determined and billed separately from labor

## Site Requirements

All scaffolding, lifts, and access equipment must be provided or arranged by the client. Equipment costs are not included in mural pricing.

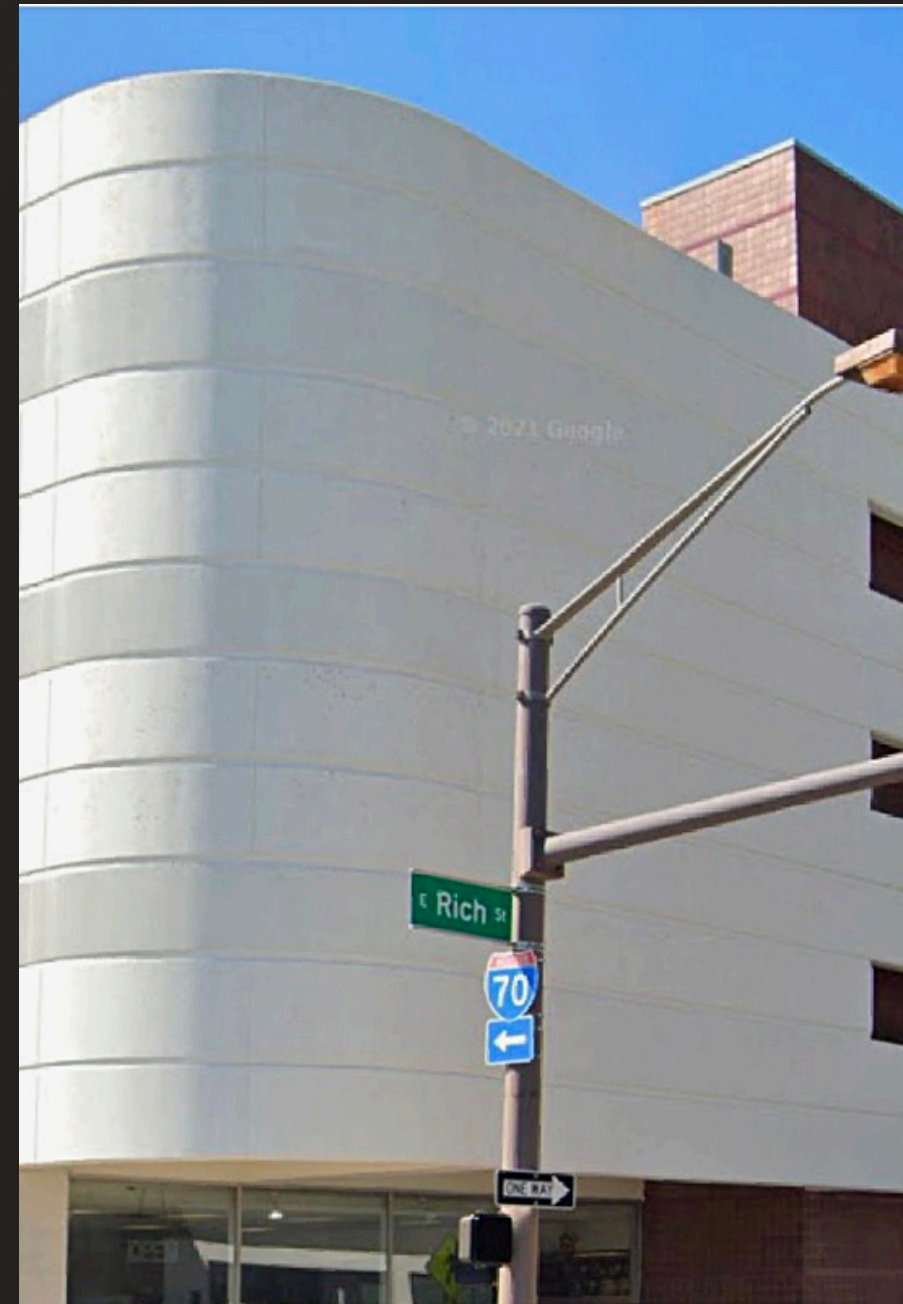
## Proposal
